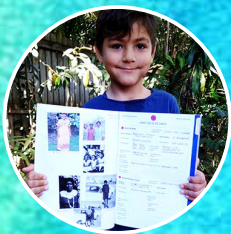
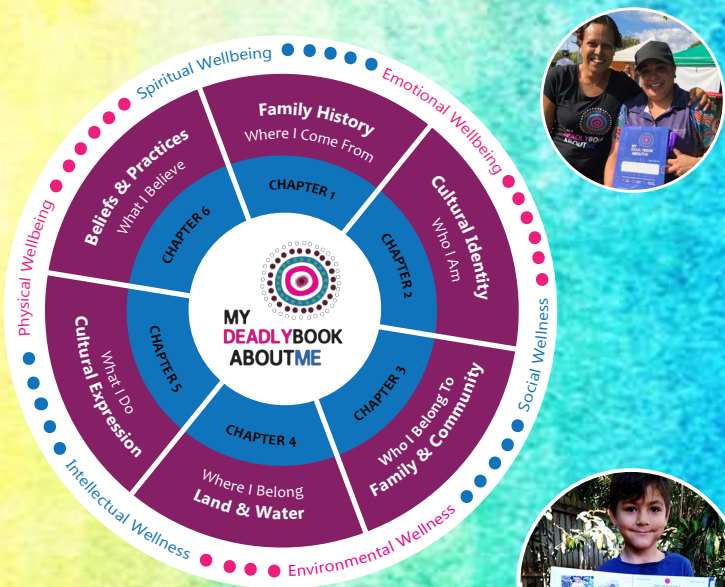

The pages are **culturally meaningful** and appropriate in their content and layout design.



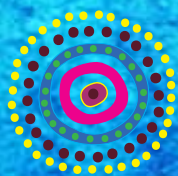
The facing **blank pages** provide opportunity to add extra notes, drawings or photos.
